I, the undersigned Centre Veterinarian, hereby certify that the semen described above and the bull from which it was collected meet the requirements of the Australian Quarantine and Inspection Service condition C8628.

1. Each semen donor has been continually resident and free from any quarantine restriction for the 60 days prior to the commencement of the 30-day pre-collection centre residency period in the Republic of Ireland, which is recognised by the OIE as a foot and mouth disease (FMD) free zone where vaccination is not practised (Article 2.1.1.2.),

The semen was not collected during the FMD exclusion period specified as being between the 1 February 2001 and the 22 June 2001.

- 2. The semen in this consignment was collected, processed and stored under conditions which comply with the standards laid down in Council Directive 88/407/EEC.

Reproductive material was not removed from containers for further processing, or aggregation with other reproductive material unless under the supervision of the Approved Veterinarian at an approved centre or laboratory.
